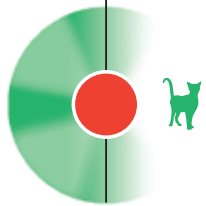

Feline Herpes Virus – cats and kittens

Feline Herpes Virus -1 [FHV-1] is a worldwide viral infection of domestic cats. Symptoms of FHV-1 include: elevated temperature, depression and poor appetite; eye and or nasal discharge, coughing, sneezing; conjunctivitis. There is no evidence that FHV-1 causes human infection.¹



Once a cat has the virus it has the virus for life. The symptoms may return when the cats is stressed by moving house, change in housing, different environment, new cats in the household or neighbourhood, change of food or other cat stressful causes. Serious symptoms of FHV-1 should receive immediate veterinary diagnosis and treatment.

A report of a study in Australia of respiratory disease in cats indicated 21.2% cats testing positive to FHV-1. Cats with recent contact with cats outside the household, with acute disease, and sneezing cats were most likely to be positive for FHV-1.²

Lysine supplement for managing Feline Herpes Virus FHV-1

Lysine is an oral amino-acid supplement which competes pharmacologically with arginine, which is required by the virus to replicate. Lysine supplementation decreases episodes of FHV-1. *Lysine has been formulated into a paste for convenient administration to cats.*

Administer 250-500 mg of lysine (1-2 ml of paste) with food (the paste may be applied to the paw and the cats will lick and consume the paste) daily. Continue administration of lysine to prevent recurrence of symptoms of FHV-1 is recommended.³

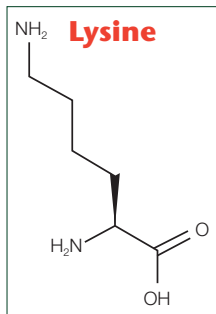


L-lysine supplementation in cats

L-lysine is an essential amino-acid important for the development and maintenance of body functions and the immune system. It is not synthesized by animals and it must be available in dietary constituents or orally supplemented. It is a particularly important supplement in sick and FHV-1-compromised cats and kittens and those that are inappetent.

Directions for Use

Each mL contains 250 mg/mL L-lysine in a palatable oral supplement for cats and kittens. The suspension may be applied to the paw or the nose, where it can be licked off; directly into the mouth, or alternatively onto food. Administer twice daily or as directed by a veterinarian.



Presentation

100 mL pump dispenser. Each pump dispenses 250 mg of L-lysine HCL. After each use cap the dispenser with the cap provided, which is attached to the bottle. This preserves the suspension and prevents contamination.

Storage

Store below 25°C.
